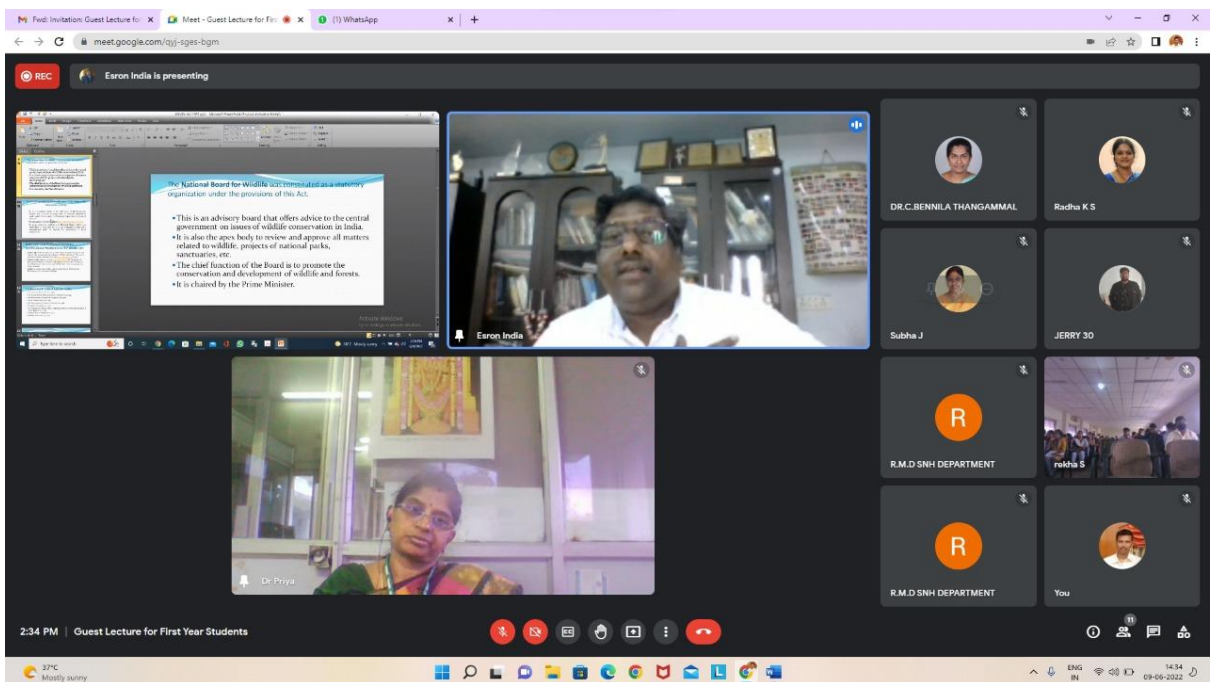
About the webinar
