Department / College. The total marks obtained in all tests put together out of 300, shall be proportionately reduced for 20 marks and rounded to the nearest integer (This also implies equal weightage to all the three tests). The remaining 20 marks will be awarded based on the other continuous assessments like MCOs (5 Marks), Assignment (5 Marks), Mini Project / Others (5 Marks), and attendance (5 Marks). Procedure for award of marks in the double valuation process is included in the Regulations 2021under the Clause 16.4. 16.4.1 If the difference of total marks obtained between two valuations is less than 15 marks, the highest mark among the two valuations will be considered for the award of marks. 16.4.2 If the difference in total marks obtained between two valuations is more than 15 marks, a third valuation is applicable. Out of the three valuations, the highest mark between two nearest marks (the mark obtained in third valuation and the marks obtained nearer to the third valuation out of the first two valuations) shall be considered for the award of marks. However, the difference between these two nearest marks must be less than 15.
