The management appreciated and awarded best performing Team with zero waste championship honour.

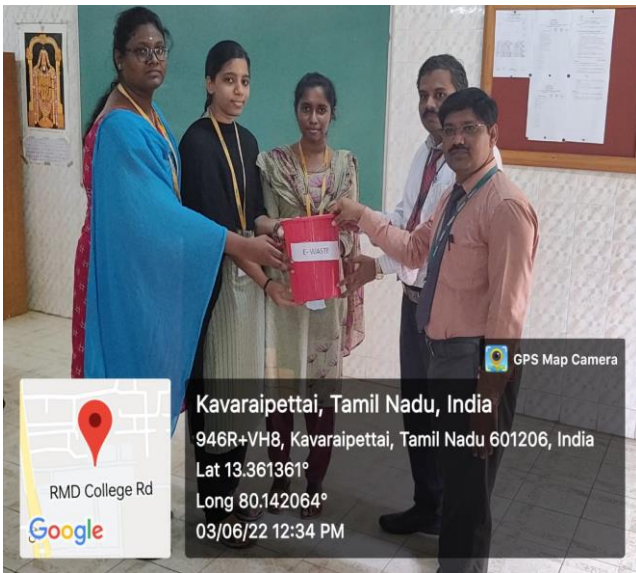

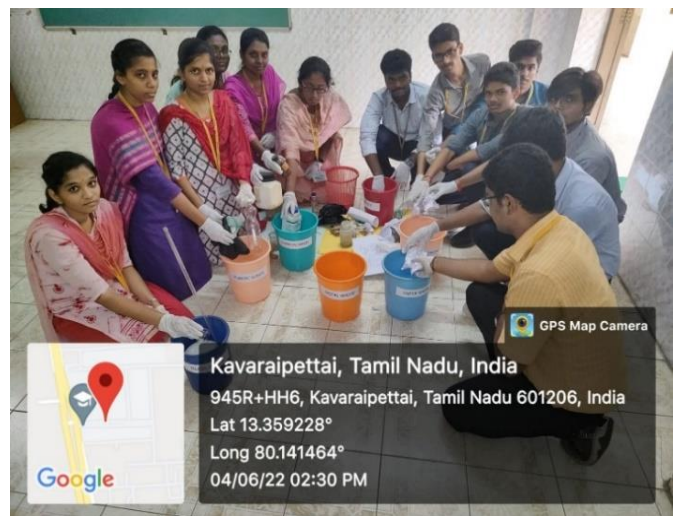
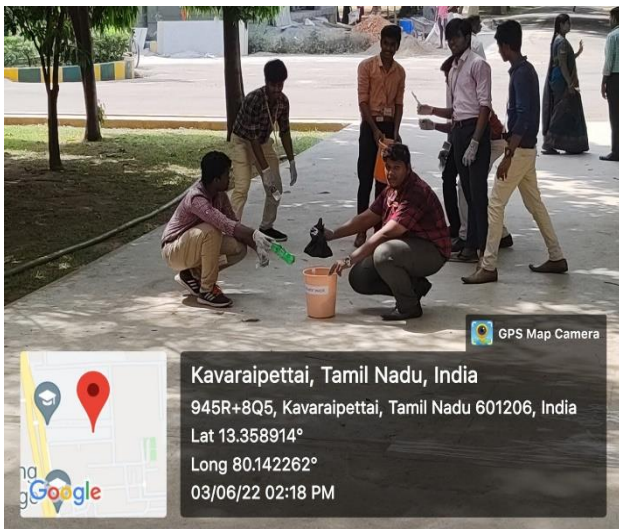
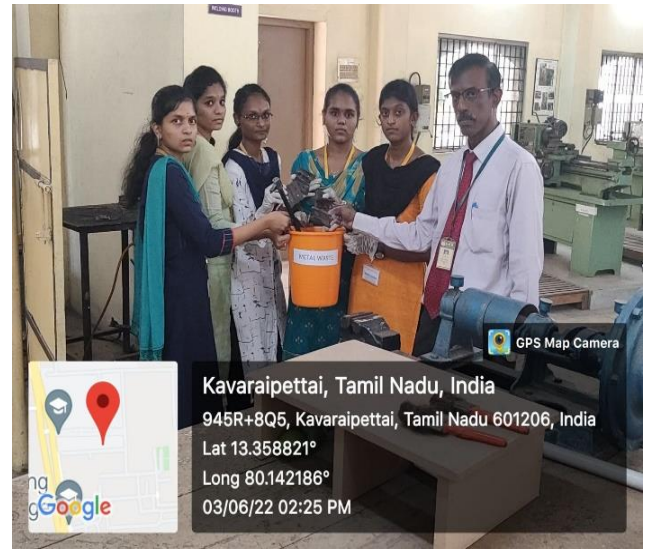
Swachhata, teams prepared a minimum of 7 bins with labels. The labels are prepared based on the nature of the material wastes generated on the campus.



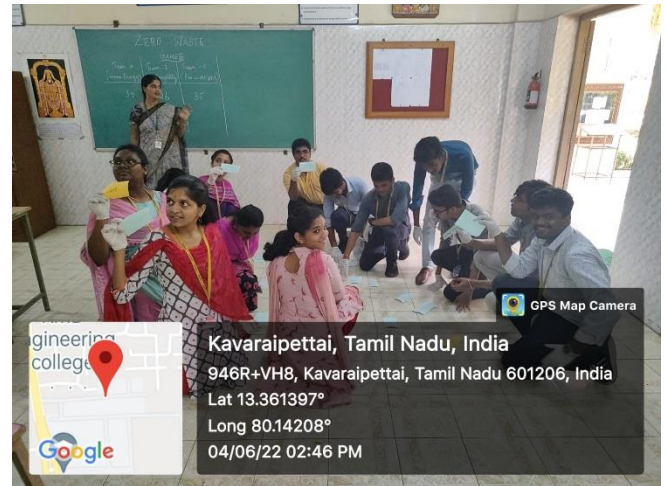
Our faculty team explained to the Swachatha teams on how to collect the various kinds of wastes from different sources on campus.

The management appreciated and awarded the best performing team with zero waste championship honor



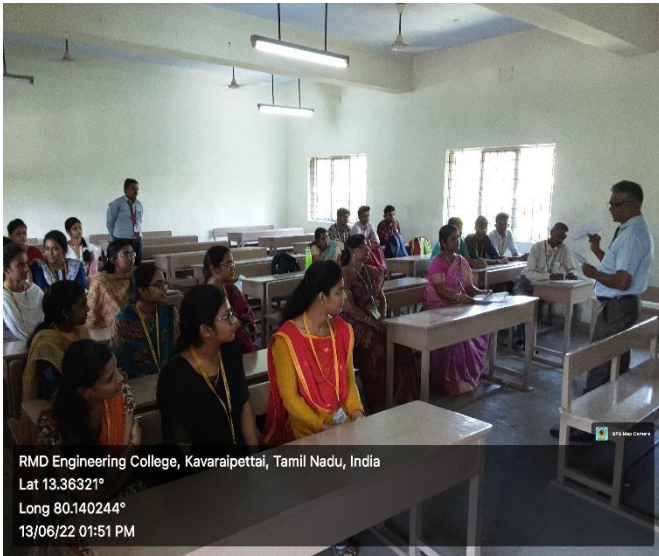
