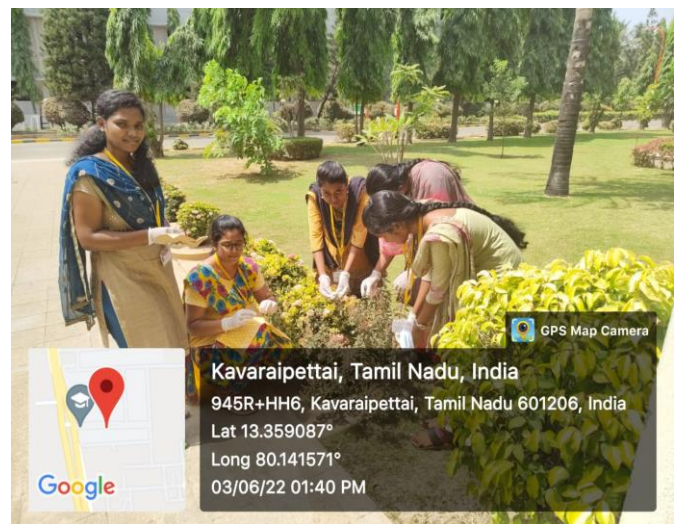
Student Green Teams were established.

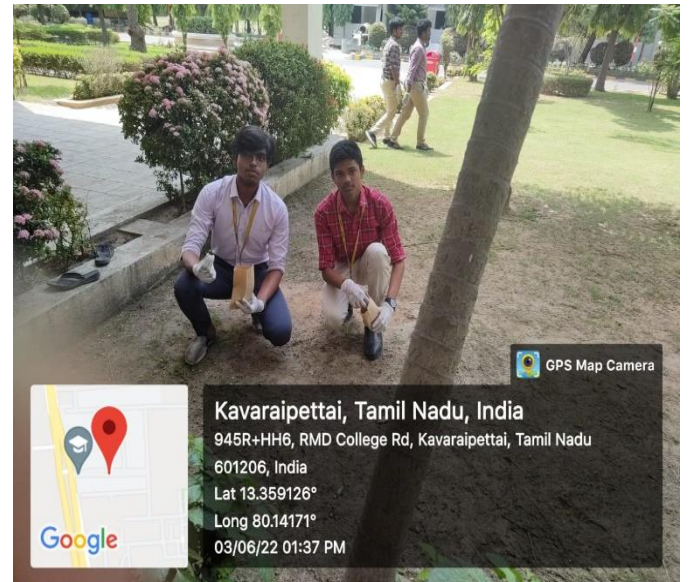
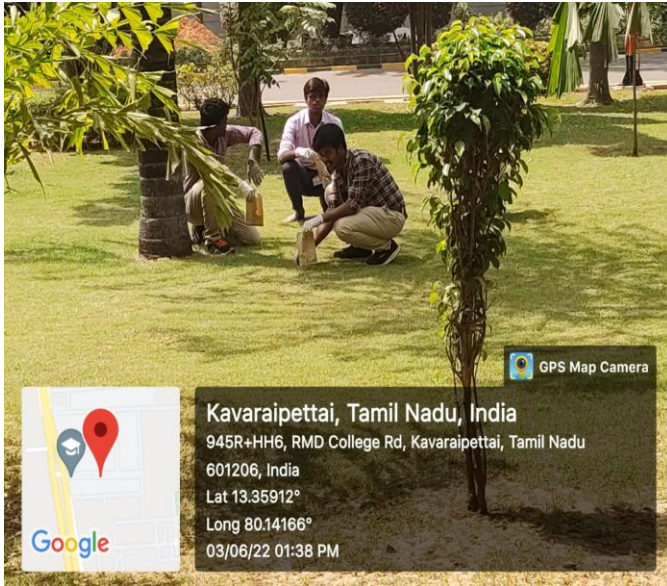
- Gathered seeds from shrubs and trees near residences and the university.

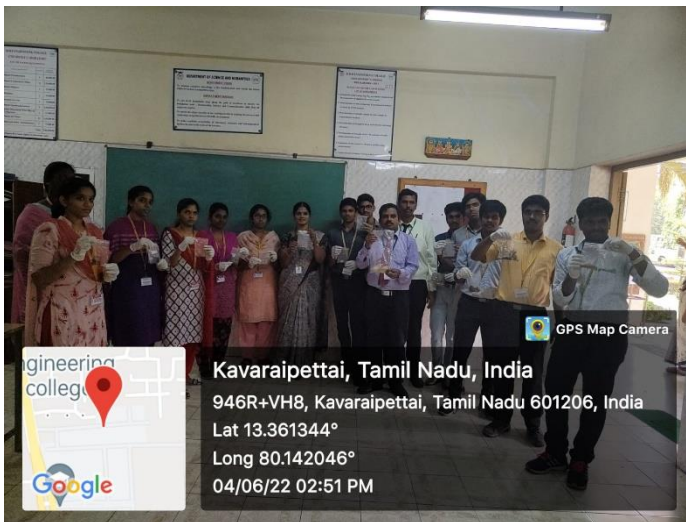




Green Student Teams collected the seeds from various trees and shrubs in and around the campus.
