Report on 'Ek Tareekh Ek Ghanta' Campaign and Dengue Awareness Rally by RMD YRC under Swachhata Hi Sewa 2023

In keeping with Swachhata Hi Sewa 2023, the RMD Youth Red Cross (YRC) Unit took proactive steps to take part in the 'Ek Tareekh Ek Ghanta' campaign. To improve cleanliness and raise awareness of dengue, the program included a focused cleaning effort and a large-scale awareness rally directed towards a government school and the nearby hamlet.

Drive for Cleaning:

The Dengue Awareness Rally spread important information about dengue prevention. YRC volunteers spoke with the locals and gave them informational brochures, emphasizing the need to remove standing water, maintain good hygiene, and apply insect repellents to lower the risk of dengue.

Outreach to the Community:

The protest spread throughout the neighboring hamlet, not just the school's grounds. Members of the RMD YRC went door-to-door, greeted the locals, and urged them to take an active role in keeping the area tidy and dengue-free. The cooperative endeavor sought to promote collective accountability for health and welfare.

Effect and Final Thoughts:

The school and the village benefited from the joint efforts of the Dengue Awareness Rally and the 'Ek Tareekh Ek Ghanta' campaign.
